

NCAA Division I Dead and Quiet Periods in Sports for Which No Recruiting Calendar Has Been Established

August 1, 2018, through July 31, 2019

Women's Gymnastics Dead Periods	 November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). December 1-30, 2018. April 18-21 (noon), 2019 (the day before the first day of the NCAA Division I Women's Gymnastics Championships to noon on the day after the championships). June 1-15, 2019.
Men's Ice Hockey Dead Periods	 November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). April 10-14 (noon), 2019 (Wednesday prior to the NCAA Division I Men's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the Sunday after the game).
Women's Ice Hockey Dead Periods and Quiet Period	 November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). March 21-25 (noon), 2019 (the day prior to the NCAA Division I Women's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the day after the match). Quiet Period: Monday prior to the American Hockey Coaches Association Convention through May 31.

Field Hockey Dead Periods	 November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). November 14-19 (noon), 2018 (Wednesday prior to the NCAA Division I Field Hockey Championship to noon on the day after the game).
Women's Soccer Dead Periods	 December 15, 2018 - January 5, 2019. November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).
Men's Soccer and Men's Water Polo Dead Periods	• November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).
All Other Sports Dead Periods	• November 12-15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent).
Exceptions: U.S. Diving National Championships (Bylaw 13.17.11.1.1)	When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the U.S. Diving National Championships, it shall be permissible for authorized coaching staff members to observe prospective student-athletes participating in that event.
North American Cup Fencing Championship (Bylaw 13.17.11.1.1.2)	When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the North American Cup Fencing Championship, it shall be permissible for authorized coaching staff members to observe prospective student-athletes participating in that event.
Junior Olympic Rifle Championships (Bylaw 13.17.11.1.1.3)	When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the Junior Olympic Rifle Championships, it shall be permissible for authorized coaching staff members to observe prospective student-athletes participating in that event.
